# The Health Care Team – Is it Right for Me?

Your career choices are some of the most important decisions of your life — they are major turning points on your path toward personal success and happiness. If personal success and happiness include helping people, learning about and using science and technology and having a secure job with good pay, then a health care career might be the right path for you.

Questions you are likely asking at this point are:

## Why should I choose a career in health care?

- Because health care is one of the largest industries in the United States.
- Employment opportunities are fantastic — just check the Sunday classified ads.
- Wages are excellent, even at entry levels.
- It's a stimulating, interesting occupation.
- Helping people gives one a great deal of personal satisfaction.
- There is a wide range of training and job opportunities.

## What qualifications do I need to have?

- If you have abilities in science and math, determination, a positive attitude, and sincere concern for the well being of other people, you have a good start. Your counselor can show you the courses you will need.

## Will I be able to find a job when I finish my education and training?

- There are more jobs than there are people to fill them — and serious shortages for nurses, physical therapists, medical technologists, respiratory therapists, imaging technologists, aides, medical assistants, and in other career choices, too.
- Shortages will be more acute in the 21st century because of an increasing number of

older Americans, new sophisticated health technologies, fewer young people in the work force, and because of a lack of awareness of the many new and exciting jobs available in health care.

## What career should I choose?

- There are more than 200 health career choices today and more developing every year. **Some jobs are fast-paced and exciting; others involve precise, detailed work. There is a place for you if you like to work with people, and a place for you if you prefer working with equipment and technology. There are health care jobs at a desk, at a microscope, in the military, in schools and laboratories, in home care — everywhere people need your helping hands or your technical skills and equipment.**
- Choose a career that you will enjoy, one that you will be willing to invest the time and work required to complete your training and education, and one that you are physically able to perform. Choose a career that meets your needs for personal fulfillment!

## Can I be in a technology center program and still be college bound?

- Absolutely! If you decide on a career early, you can plan your courses and schedule time for vocational classes. The competencies you learn can help you in your college program.

## What is my future in a health career?

- You can begin a career ladder in high school and continue to advance at your own pace.
- Professional training courses and certification programs are available at almost all levels. Many employers will provide and help fund advanced training.
- With new positions opening each year, there's unlimited opportunity to change and grow.
- With flexible hours in many positions, you can adapt your working schedule as your needs change.
- Shifts in job demand can occur over short periods of time. These changes can affect job security. They also open the door for new training and advancement.
- You can travel if that's your dream. Health care professionals are needed throughout Oklahoma, the United States, and the world.

# Getting Experience Before Making a Career Decision

## Opportunities for Experience

- Summer, part-time, and volunteer work at a hospital or clinic;
- Various branches of the military service;
- Participation in cooperative programs at a technical center or college.

## Work-Based Learning

Work-based learning takes many forms. At one end of the spectrum is job shadowing, which gives students opportunities to observe an adult at work. At the other end are more intensive experiences such as internships, which reinforce classroom lessons and also teach new skills that are required for particular careers. Each type of activity provides a way for students to see workplaces in action and explore future career options.

## What Does Work-Based Learning Look Like in Practice?

Here's a sampling of the variety of work-based learning strategies that are being used in schools and businesses around the country:

### ➤ Job Shadowing

Students learn about the demands of a particular job, and generally see what it's like to be an adult in the workplace, by spending part of a day or a longer period of time observing an employee on the job. This activity usually occurs in late middle school or early high school.

### ➤ Mentoring

Students are assigned to an adult mentor, inside or outside the school, who acts as an adviser, motivator and constructive critic.

Ideally the mentor is in a career the student finds interesting and models the skills and knowledge required for that career.

### ➤ School-based Enterprises

Students learn about business by actually operating one. Whether on or off campus, the enterprise is always part of the school program. Students get to experience all aspects of the business. As an example, students could host a community health screening during the school year.

### ➤ Externships

Students work for a health employer for a specified block of time to learn about a particular industry or occupation. Because the experience is tied to schoolwork, they may receive academic credit. They also may be paid for their time.

### ➤ Service Learning

Students volunteer to perform community service in programs that equally emphasize learning and caring. Their volunteer experiences are integrated with academic course work.

## **Is a Health Care Career in Your Future? Start Preparing Today!**

### **Consider and remember:**

- **Competition for enrollment in some programs can be tough. Be sure to apply early, know the deadlines, and meet them.**
- **Choose at least three programs that you are interested in and willing to pursue. Apply for all of them with equal care and thoroughness.**
- **For programs that require college work — such as physician, registered nurse, physical therapy, etc. — grades are important in getting accepted.**
- **In programs that require clinical practice, check on the number and locations of openings for clinical study. These programs may limit enrollment, and you may have to go to a different school in order to reach your goal.**
- **Be sure the program you choose qualifies you for registration, certification or licensure, if required, and that the school is recognized by the appropriate accrediting agency.**
- **Don't limit yourself to preparing for only one career, especially for programs with limited enrollment, such as medical school. Acceptance requirements are high and competition is tough. Consider an education that will allow you to work in another related field.**
- **Know the job outlook before you pursue any career. If you want to live in a certain area, find out about the job market there. As the information below shows, job opportunities in health care are good.**

## **Health Care Job Outlook**

Health care careers are still the rising stars of the employment outlook. According to the Department of Labor, more new wage and salary jobs — about 19 percent, or 3.6 million — created between 2004 and 2014 will be in health care than in any other industry.<sup>1</sup> Eight out of 20 occupations expected to grow the fastest are in health care.<sup>1</sup>

As the largest industry in 2004, health care provided 13.5 million jobs.<sup>1</sup> This represented nearly 10 percent of the

national total workforce — a significant portion of the overall labor market activity with tremendous economic power.

In 2004, health care was the second largest employing industry in Oklahoma, providing 198,636 jobs, or 14 percent of the state's total employment.<sup>2</sup> By 2012, Oklahoma will employ nearly 43,000 RNs and LPNs, a 22 percent increase from 2004.<sup>2</sup> Nearly 1,500 open nursing positions are expected each year until 2012.

Registered nursing jobs alone are projected to increase by 15 percent over the next six years, and radiologic technology jobs are projected to increase by 26 percent during the same time. Within the allied health professions, a 24 percent job growth is expected between 2004 and 2012.<sup>2</sup>

Statewide surveys of hospitals conducted by the Oklahoma Hospital Association from 2001-2005 indicate Oklahoma hospitals' greatest needs are for the following clinical

workers: nurses, respiratory therapists, imaging technologists, pharmacists, medical and laboratory technologists, physical and occupational therapists and scrub/surgical technicians.

## Tips for Students

### Ask a Counselor or Advisor

What kind of job will I be qualified for when I graduate? What is the job market in this field? Are there jobs available? Where are they located — in rural areas? In Oklahoma? In other states? Knowing where you can be working, as well as what you can do with a particular major, is very important.

You should also contact a prospective employer and ask about the need and opportunity in his or her preferred fields.

### Take Advantage of Career Days

The sooner your career path is chosen, the better prepared you will be when it is time for college or vocational training.

Hospitals, professional associations, county medical societies and auxiliaries are often interested in supporting career activities such as touring a hospital or facility. The schools and hospitals listed in this document can provide materials for career days upon request.

### Take Advantage of Clubs, Organizations, and Related Activities

Pre-med clubs, local volunteer organizations, and various programs offered in the community can broaden your understanding and reinforce your learning and career choices. Be aware of opportunities such as Special Olympics, first aid and CPR classes, lectures, and demonstrations related to health care careers.

In today's world, few career areas offer the range of choices available to you in the health care industry. On the other hand, few careers have such demanding requirements for admission and graduation. And at the same time, no career is as exciting and rewarding as being a part of the health care team.

# Tips for Counselors

## Encourage Students to:

### Look Ahead

Make sure they have met the career prerequisites. Students interested in a health career should take all the math and science possible. However, there are many health care career options available to students who do not have strong math and science skills, so do not discourage those who believe they are not skilled in math or science.

### Enroll Early

Begin the enrollment and application process for programs a full year BEFORE THEY PLAN TO BE ACCEPTED. Missing an enrollment or application deadline can mean considerable delay in and worry about reaching their career goals.

### Think Work, Not Subject

Think about what kind of WORK they might be doing with their education — not just what subjects they like. Experience in job placement with college graduates who have degrees in “subjects” that don’t qualify them for “jobs” points this out on an almost daily basis. A health care career can offer students a variety of possibilities, many of which are outlined in this booklet.

### Have Alternative Options Ready

Make sure students have other options in case coursework or abilities do not correlate with high entrance requirements.

## Get Some Experience Before Making Career Decisions

Get work experience that will expose them to the type of career they are considering. Some possibilities include volunteer work, job shadowing, externship, summer or part-time work. Students can determine from practical experience whether they like the work and the hospital environment. They may discover that they want to focus on a certain area of health care, or find that a different direction in health care is more appealing. For more information on work-based learning, see page 6.

## Ensuring Student Success

### Students Should Like

Working with people; activities of a scientific and technical nature; working with processes, machines, and techniques; and helping people.

### Students Should Be Able To

Communicate well; work effectively with others; evaluate information based on personal judgment and/or measurable standards; perform a variety of duties that may change frequently; use logical, clear, step-by-step procedures in their work; and work with precise limits or standards of accuracy.

### Possible Physical Abilities

Have good vision, either naturally or with correction; hear well, either naturally or with correction; possess manual dexterity and use of fingers, hands and arms; have good perception of depth and color; have the ability to assist in lifting patients and/or equipment; and possess the ability to stand for long periods of time.

### Sources of Preparation

On-the-job training, technology centers, community colleges, universities, graduate schools, and military training.
